

CONFIDENTIALITY & PRIVACY NOTICE

The 21st Century Cyber Charter School (21CCCS) protects the confidentiality of personally identifiable information regarding screening, referral, evaluation, storage, disclosure, and destruction of all information for students in accordance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974 and other applicable federal and state laws.

Parents/guardians have the right to inspect and review their child's educational record. 21CCCS will comply with a request to inspect and review educational records without unnecessary delay and before any meeting regarding an IEP or any due process hearing, but no later than 30 days after the written request has been made. Parents/guardians have the right to a response from the school to reasonable requests for explanations and interpretations of the records.

Parents/guardians have the right to request copies of their child's records. Parents/guardians have the right to appoint a representative to inspect and review their child's records. If any educational record contains information on more than one child, parents/guardians have the right only to inspect and review the information relating to their child.

Additionally, 21CCCS must have a parent's, guardian's, or eligible student's consent prior to disclosure of education records. The consent must be signed, dated, and state the purpose of the disclosure.
